Code of Conduct

It is accepted that for Junior Members, it may be harder to explain, or comprehend the requirements of a Code of Conduct. As such we ask that parents/guardians accept this responsibility on behalf of their child, and assist in guiding them, our members, in better understanding appropriate behaviour in line with this code.

All members of the Kingston & Elmbridge Junior Snorkellers Club are bound by the following codes of conduct, in addition to abiding by the British Sub Aqua Club Code of Conduct (available on the BSAC Web Page or on request).

This Code should be read in conjunction with the KEJSC Club Rules.

All members shall:

- a) Be supportive and encouraging of their peers in their attempts to learn the sport.
- b) Treat all staff members with respect commensurate with their position.
- c) Act in a polite and courteous manner
- d) Not engage in derogatory, bullying or other negative behaviour against their peers or other members.
- e) Conduct themselves with discipline, following all rules, and requests of any Instructor.
- f) Present themselves professionally when representing the club whether on poolside, in open water, or other public events.
- g) Inform a staff member of any injury or illness that would make them unfit for diving/snorkelling activities (alternative support and options can be provided).
- h) Notify the club of any known absence, either through illness or other commitment.
- i) Not enter the water prior to any session starting, or before being briefed by an instructor. (This is for safety reasons and financial. Outside of our sessions, the pool is public access and not protected by the same safeguarding levels as the club. Additionally any use outside of our sessions must be paid for.)
- j) Care for and maintain any equipment loaned or hired to them by the club, and ensure it remains in a functional state for subsequent reissue.
- k) Use any training equipment during a training session in an appropriate manner, in line with instruction.
- l) Treat other members equipment with respect
